After 2 rounds of preliminary selection, 29 groups were finally selected from the 39 short-listed entries with a total of 99 designs for the Final round.

The annual fashion show has become an established tradition in Lam Tai Fai College and as a platform to offer students learning in a diversified, balanced and authentic learning environment, it will be faithfully kept up in years to come.
