Students can understand the historical events of China's Anti-Japanese War, learnt the indomitable spirit of defending the country, and recognize the importance of maintaining homeland security. Students also understood the industrial development of Shenzhen's innovative technology and the opportunities it brings, cultivate the spirit of pioneering and innovation, and interest in innovative technology. It is suggested to arrange 1-2 mainland visits for students to help them study and explore the culture and development of Mainland China.
- It is suggested that the school can arrange a long-distance tour in 2023-2024 for senior form students so that students and teachers can stay 5 to 6 days to have an in-depth visit and study to understand and explore different topics from multiple perspectives about the situations and opportunities of China and Hong Kong relating to the CSD curriculum.
